

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS

The Board of Police Commissioners is an independent board that is responsible for providing policing service to maintain a reasonable standard of law enforcement and for providing adequate and reasonable facilities.

Consideration for service on this Board includes the following core attributes, competencies and experience:

- Understanding of the distinction between the strategic and policy setting role of the Board and the operational responsibilities of the Chief;
- Capacity to give leadership to the development of the Board and the Police Service;
- Commitment to the vision, mission, values and strategic goals of the Board;
- Ability to work as a member of a team;
- Respect for and tolerance of the views of others;
- Recognition of the time commitment and the willingness to devote the time and energy necessary to perform the role of a board member;
- Enthusiasm and capacity for resolving challenging issues; and
- Knowledge and appreciation for family systems and community dynamics from Indigenous and diversified communities.

The Board meets monthly on the third Thursday at 4:00 p.m. There are no meetings in July or August. There is no remuneration paid to Board members.

Interested applicants are asked to submit an application and resumé with two letters of reference by no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, October 4, 2019**, using the Committee Application Form found online at saskatoon.ca/boards. All applications will be kept on file and reviewed throughout the year should further vacancies occur.
