

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS SASKATOON PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD

The Saskatoon Public Library Board helps connect the citizens of Saskatoon to lifelong learning and engagement opportunities in order to meet present and future challenges. The Board fills a governance role for the municipal library system as outlined in *The Public Libraries Act*; and to ensure that library programs, services and facilities meet the needs of the citizens of Saskatoon.

Consideration for service on this Board includes the following general qualifications and one or more of the specific skill sets:

- Knowledge of the public library and its services;
- Possession of a valid library card;
- Connections with Indigenous community and commitment to reconciliation;
- Involvement with early childhood literacy programming;
- Experience with capital campaigns and fund development;
- Connections with New Canadians;
- Financial expertise;
- Philanthropic connections; and
- Legal expertise

The Board holds a minimum of eight meetings per year, on the third Wednesday of the month at 4:00 p.m. Additional meeting time is held each month should it be needed. Committee work is scheduled over and above meetings. Typically there are no meetings in July and August. There is no remuneration paid to Board members.

Interested applicants are asked to submit an application and resumé with two letters of reference by no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Friday, October 4, 2019**, using the Committee Application Form and Reference Form found online at saskatoon.ca/boards. All applications will be kept on file and reviewed throughout the year should further vacancies occur.
