Re: Utility Disconnect on Self-Generation Solar Projects

Saskatoon Light & Power no longer requires the Utility Disconnect Switch for Customer Self-Generation systems be located beside the Utility Meter. The Utility Disconnect Switch is to be outside, readily accessible and clearly labelled as the "Utility Disconnect" as per Canadian Electric Code (CEC) 84-022 and 84-024. As well, there must be a warning notice of an interconnected system and a permanent single line diagram of the interconnected system at the utility disconnect and utility meter as per CEC 84-030.
